

The Chamber of Commerce Industry and Agriculture of Beirut and Mount Lebanon (CCIA-BML) is a non-profit private organization working for the public benefit. It was established in 1898 and is today the largest of the four Lebanese Chambers.

Its strategy aims at stimulating all sectors of economic activity and enabling them to contribute to the development of a strong and competitive national economy through the elimination of the impediments hindering private investment. Within that perspective, the Chamber has reinforced the existing partnership between the private and the public sectors, and tightened coordination with other Chambers, sector associations and organizations of the civil society.

The Chamber has been certified by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) since 2004 and has successfully sustained the quality requirements of that certification.
