The logo was designed based on the acronym MA'AM which is spelt in Arabic with the three following letters (from right to left)



Almost all of the old Arabic words are derived from verbs of three consonants. Accents replace the vowels. MA'AM is derived from the verb AMMA that is to aim at, head towards, desire, seek and lead people to prayer... MA'AM, by extension, means "the place that we aim towards or to which we are heading. It is "the path", so to speak. An interesting relation also links AMMA to AIM in English.
